

Annual Report - Anglican Foodbank
for the year ended 31 December 2024

In 2024, the Anglican Foodbank provided 49 parcels supporting 214 people.

The rising cost of living affected a diverse range of individuals seeking assistance, including workers, families, and grandparents. Regular donations from the congregation, monthly food donations from the Holy Family, Catholic Church, and monetary contributions from the Op-Shop helped keep the Foodbank pantry stocked.

Suggestions from the congregation improved food parcels and service delivery. A grant enabled the replacement of an old freezer with a new Fridge/Freezer.
